Please allow at least <u>six months</u> of preparation time. Date arrangements are made after the initial meet with pastor before any other commitments are made.


Ministry of the Sick

SIXTH SUNDAY OF PENTECOST SEASON Jesus sends out his Apostles July 14, 2019



When Jesus sends out the twelve he tells them not to take money, food or a bag (eg. luggage) but to accept the hospitality of whomever offers it. This is a blessing: we all can serve the Lord when we welcome each other.

They were not to take anything with them for the Lord would provide through his people. It was both a test and a blessing.

But they would also receive opposition as some towns would not receive them: Leave, and shake off the dust off your feet. In essence Jesus said not to bang your head against a brick wall. If the people didn't want to hear the word, don't try to shove it down their throat. Just move on, go somewhere else where the people would be more receptive.
