Equal Voting Rights for All Lebanese



Petition: Demand for the Repeal of Article 112 of the Current Electoral Law

What You Need To Know About Signing The Petition

Lebanese citizens abroad will only be allowed to vote for 6 parliamentary seats in the 2026 Lebanese elections, not the full 128 seats like those living in Lebanon.

This limits the right of the Lebanese Diaspora to share Lebanon's future. The law must change, and Lebanese Diaspora voters should have the same rights as those in Lebanon.

His Eminence and Beatitude Cardinal Bechara Peter Rai has also spoken in favor of the Lebanese Diaspora.

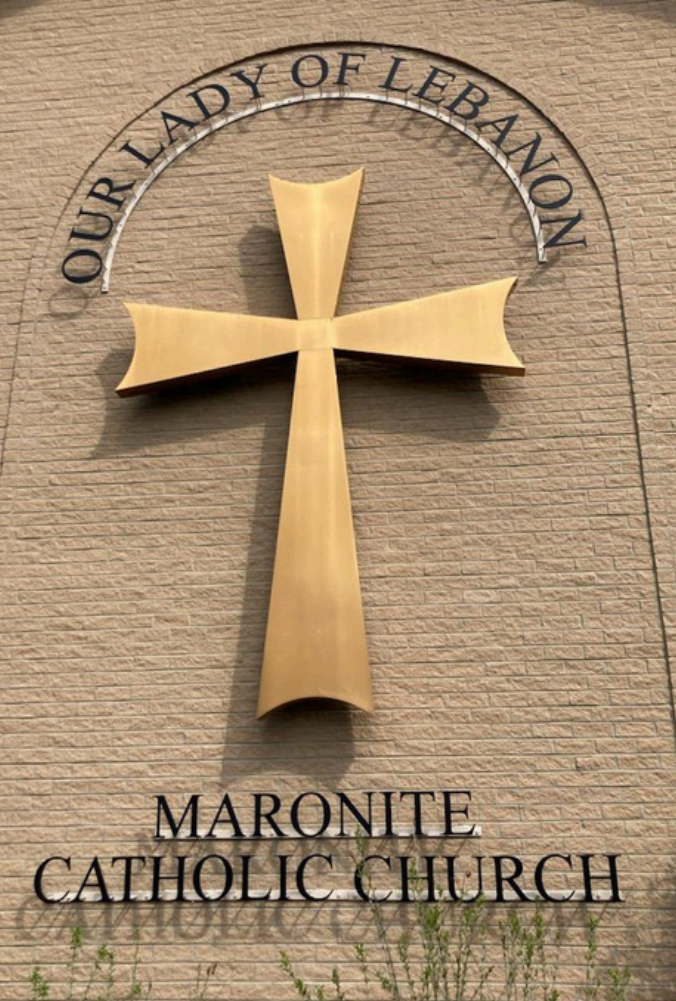
