The Acts of the Apostles;

Brothers and Sisters, when the day of Pentecost had come, they were all together in one place. And suddenly there came from the sky a noise like a strong driving wind, and it filled the entire house in which they were. Then there appeared to them tongues as of fire, which parted and came to rest on each one of them. And they were all filled with the Holy Spirit and began to speak in different tongues, as the Spirit enabled them to proclaim.

At this sound, the Jews who were staying in Jerusalem, they gathered in a large crowd. They were confused and they asked, "Are not all these people who are speaking Galileans? Then how does each of us hear them in his own native language? They were all astounded and bewildered, and said to one another, "What does this mean?" But others said, scoffing, "They have had too much wine."

Then Peter stood up with the Eleven, raised his voice, and said to them, "These people are not drunk, as you suppose; No, This is what was spoken through the prophet Joel: 'It will come to pass in the last days, God says, that I will pour out a portion of my spirit upon all flesh. Your sons and your daughters shall prophesy, your young men shall see visions, your old men shall dream dreams. Indeed, upon my servants and my handmaids I will pour out a portion of my spirit in those days. And I will work wonders in the heavens above and signs on the earth below: blood, fire, and a cloud of smoke. The sun shall be turned to darkness, and the moon to blood, before the coming of the great and splendid day of the Lord. And it shall be that everyone who calls on the name of the Lord will be saved.
