

Cana Sunday What Does It Mean?

Cana Sunday is celebrated in the Maronite Catholic Church the day before Ash Monday- the start of Lent. Why is this important? and Why do The Maronite Church start the Lent with Jesus changing the water into wine?

Because Lent is a celebration of God changing our lives and our heart from the way of sin to the way of the children of God.

It is God who sent his son as a bridegroom for his people and in celebration of this wedding he changed the wine into his blood to save his bride, the Church.

The Miracle at Cana is the miracle of each one of us when God will change us from sinners into believers and then from believers into his own children who are sanctified by his blood.

7 Facts About Lent In The Maronite Rite

1. Lent starts on Ash Monday (not Ash Wednesday)

- 2. It lasts 40 Days from Ash Monday until Palm Sunday, symbolizes Jesus' 40-day fast in the desert.
- 3. The 40 Days of Lent prepare the believers for the Holy week of Jesus suffering, Death, and Resurrection.
 - 4. During Lent, we abstain & fast from food & water.
 - 5. People should do good works of mercy and receive, at least once, the Sacrament of Confession.
- 6. Lent is a penitential season for repentance, reflection & renewal of our commitment to Jesus & our Faith.

7. Purple is the liturgical color during Mass.


