- Altar Servers** A boy/girl, 3<sup>rd</sup> grade to High School, who has received his/her First Holy Communion, is eligible to be an Altar Server.
- Lectors** Adults and high school students who proclaim the Scripture readings during Mass.
- Choir & Music** Talented people to enhance our Liturgical Celebrations.
- Ushers** Welcome parishioners and visitors to our Liturgical Celebrations, maintain good order at worship and collect the offerings.
- Fellowship** Organize Post Liturgy hospitality and Consolidate social gathering.
- Religious Education (RE)** Help raise faith-filled children together. Classes range from Pre-school to 7<sup>th</sup> grade.
- Maronite Youth Organization (MYO)** promotes the spiritual welfare of its members, strengthens youth groups (ages 13 to 18 years old) in the Maronite faith.
